### AN ACT PROVIDING FOR A HIGHER MINIMUM SALARY FOR PUBLIC SCHOOL TEACHERS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 40 of chapter 71 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by striking out the first sentence, as most recently  
3 amended by section 1 of chapter 602 of the acts of 1959, and  
4 inserting in place thereof the following sentence:— The com-  
5 pensation of every teacher employed in any public day school  
6 in the commonwealth, except persons in training and those  
7 employed as temporary substitutes, shall be at a rate of not  
8 less than five thousand and two hundred dollars for the school  
9 year.
