- 4 inserting in place thereof the following sentence: The com-
- 5 pensation of every teacher employed in any public day school
- 6 in the commonwealth, except persons in training and those
- 7 employed as temporary substitutes, shall be at a rate of not
- 8 less than five thousand and two hundred dollars for the school
- 9 year.
