AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE POSTING OF A FIVE MILE DIFFERENTIAL BETWEEN THE SPEED OF PLEASURE VEHICLES AND COMMERCIAL VEHICLES ON ROADS CONTROLLED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS AND THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION RESPECTIVELY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law
2 to the contrary, the department of public works and the metro-
3 politan district commission is hereby authorized and directed
4 to establish a five mile differential between the speed of pleasure
5 vehicles and commercial vehicles and post such speeds on high-
6 ways controlled by them respectively.
