

HOUSE No. 788

By Mr. Donohue of Woburn (by request), petition of James W. O'Neill and others for a referendum to the voters of the town of Wilmington on the question of the continuance of fluoridation of the water supply of said town. Public Health.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-One.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE VOTERS OF THE TOWN OF WILMINGTON SHALL DETERMINE WHETHER OR NOT THE WATER SUPPLY OF SAID TOWN SHALL CONTINUE TO BE FLUORIDATED.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The following question shall be placed upon the official ballot
2 to be used for the election of officers at the annual town meeting
3 in the current year in the town of Wilmington: — “Shall the
4 fluoridation of the water supply of the town of Wilmington be
5 continued?” If a majority of the votes in answer to said ques-
6 tion is in the affirmative, the fluoridation of the water supply of
7 said town shall be continued, otherwise it shall be discontinued.
