## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-One.

AN ACT TO RELEASE CERTAIN RESTRICTIONS IMPOSED BY DEEDS OF THE COMMONWEALTH ON LAND IN THE BACK BAY DISTRICT IN THE CITY OF BOSTON.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The lands in the Back Bay district of the city of Boston con-  
2 veyed by the commonwealth by deeds imposing thereon a  
3 restriction that no cellar or lower floor of any building shall  
4 be placed more than four feet below the level of the mill dam  
5 as fixed by the top surface of the hammered stone at the south-  
6 easterly corner of the emptying sluices, are hereby, subject to  
7 the rights, if any there be, of parties other than the common-  
8 wealth, released from the operation and effect of said restriction.
