AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE EMPLOYMENT OF VETERANS IN THE LABOR SERVICE OF REGIONAL SCHOOL DISTRICTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 71 of the General Laws is hereby amended by insert-  
2 ing after section 16F the following section:—

3 *Section 16G.* In regional school districts in which the pro-  
4 visions of chapter thirty-one and the rules governing the civil  
5 service have not been applied to the labor service, every neces-  
6 sary action shall be taken to secure the employment of veterans  
7 in the labor service, in preference to all other persons except  
8 women.

Chapter II of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting the following section:

Section 101. In addition to the duties now imposed upon the State Treasurer, he shall also be charged with the duty of receiving and depositing in the State Treasury all moneys which may be received by the State Treasurer in the exercise of his office.
