AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE AFFIXING OF NOTARIAL SEAL ON AFFIDAVIT OF APPLICANT FOR ABSENTEE BALLOT AND REQUIRING THAT THE EXPIRATION DATE OF THE COMMISSION OF NOTARY PUBLIC OR JUSTICE OF THE PEACE SHALL BE INDICATED.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Clause (c) of section 87 of chapter 54 of the
2 General Laws, as amended by section 2 of chapter 466 of the
3 acts of 1945, is hereby further amended by striking cut at the
4 end of the second paragraph of the first affidavit the words
5 "(seal, if any)".

1 SECTION 2. Clause (c) of section 87 of chapter 54 of the
2 General Laws, as amended, is hereby further amended by insert-
3 ing after the word "rank" in the last line of the first affidavit
4 the words: — (date of expiration of commission of notary public
5 or justice of the peace).
