AN ACT RELATING TO FIRE INSURANCE POLICIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 175 of the General Laws is hereby amended by in-2 serting after section 99 the following section:—
- 3 Section 99A. Insurers issuing the standard policy pursuant
- 4 to section ninety-nine are authorized to affix thereto or include
- 5 therein a written statement that the policy does not cover loss
- 6 or damage caused by nuclear reaction or nuclear radiation or
- 7 radioactive contamination, all whether directly or indirectly
- 8 resulting from an insured peril under said policy; provided,
- 9 however, that nothing herein contained shall be construed to
- 10 prohibit the attachment to any such policy of an endorsement
- 11 or endorsements specifically assuming coverage for loss or damage
- or endorsements specifically assuming coverage for loss of damage
- 12 caused by nuclear reaction or nuclear radiation or radioactive
- 13 contamination.
