The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-One.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE GOVERNOR OF THE COMMONWEALTH TO APPOINT A RESIDENT OF EITHER ESSEX, ROCKPORT OR GLOUCESTER ASSOCIATE JUSTICE OF THE DISTRICT COURT OF EASTERN ESSEX.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The governor of the commonwealth is hereby authorized and
- 2 directed to appoint a resident of either Essex, Rockport or
- 3 Gloucester (which is, in fact, the judicial district of the district
- 4 court of eastern Essex) associate justice of the district court of
- 5 eastern Essex to replace the late associate justice, Lincoln
- 6 Simonds, and that said associate justice be compensated accord-
- 7 ing to the provisions of General Laws, chapter two hundred and
- 8 eighteen.
