AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE TRANSFER OF THE LAND WITHIN FRANKLIN PARK FROM THE CITY OF BOSTON TO THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The park department of the city of Boston is
2 hereby authorized and directed to release to the metropolitan
3 district commission for their care, custody, and control, lands
4 within Franklin park as herein described:— Long Crouch
5 Woods, consisting of 21 acres, bounded by Seaver Street, Old
6 Trail Road, Playstead Road and Walnut Avenue.

1 SECTION 2. This area to be developed for the exhibition of
2 zoological specimens. The existing bear dens are located in the
3 center of this tract.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
