AN ACT RELATIVE TO GRANTING NON-CONTRIBUTORY PENSIONS TO CERTAIN POLICE OFFICERS AFTER THIRTY YEARS OF SERVICE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 83A of chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out paragraph (c) and inserting in place
3 thereof the following paragraph:—

4 (c) Any permanent member of said department, at his re-
5 quest, if he has performed thirty years of faithful service therein,
6 or at any time after attaining the age of sixty and before attain-
7 ing the age of sixty-five, if he has performed faithful service
8 therein for not less than twenty years.
