## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-One.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RETIREMENT RIGHTS OF CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC UTILITIES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, Edward  
2 J. McAuliffe, Francis J. Sullivan, Joseph Mandell, and George  
3 F. Keegan presently employed by the department of public  
4 utilities shall be allowed as creditable service for purposes of  
5 retirement that period of time served by them in the employ of  
6 the Boston Elevated Railway Company and the Metropolitan  
7 Transit Authority; provided, that each of said persons, before  
8 the date any retirement allowance becomes effective for him,  
9 pays into the state retirement fund an amount equal to that  
10 which would have been withheld as regular deductions from his  
11 regular compensation had he been eligible for membership and  
12 been a member of the state retirement system during such  
13 period, together with regular interest thereon to date of final  
14 payment thereof.
