**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-One.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THERE SHALL BE A DOCTOR IN ATTENDANCE  
AT ALL TIMES IN ALL HOSPITALS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 There shall be at least one doctor, who has been properly
- 2 registered and qualified in accordance with the requirements
- 3 of the General Laws, in attendance at all times in all hospitals.
