The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-One.

AN ACT ESTABLISHING A MINIMUM FEE FOR DEPUTY BOXING COMMISSIONERS ASSIGNED TO BOXING EXHIBITIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 12 of chapter 22 of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended by striking out the last sentence and inserting
3 in place thereof the following sentence:— Such persons may
4 receive such compensation for actual services as shall be fixed by
5 rule or regulation of the commission, but in no event shall pay-
6 ment for said actual services be less than fifteen dollars, together
7 with their traveling expenses necessarily incurred in the discharge
8 of their duties.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

The Constitution of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Sixty-Six

AN ACT RELATIVE TO A REVISION OF THE CONSTITUTION OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 12 of chapter 21 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the last sentence and inserting in place thereof the following sentence:— "Such persons may be chosen and may hold office for the term of years as shall be fixed by the Legislature of the Commonwealth, but in no event shall they hold office for more than two years, and no person shall be eligible for a second term unless he has held office for less than two years."—

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
