AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE DIRECTOR OF PERSONNEL
AND STANDARDIZATION TO REALLOCATE THE POSITION OF INVESTIGATOR
IN THE REGISTRY OF MOTOR VEHICLES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law
2 to the contrary, the director of personnel and standardization
3 is hereby authorized and directed to reallocate the position of
4 investigator in the registry of motor vehicles from job group
5 twelve to job group thirteen.

The Commission of Enquiry

In the Year of the Lord 1885

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That the Commission of Enquiry, created by the Act of the 23rd March 1884, be and the same are hereby authorized to continue their duties until the 31st day of December 1885.

And be it further enacted, That the Commission of Enquiry shall have the same powers and authority as are conferred upon the Commission of Enquiry by the Act of the 23rd March 1884.

And be it further enacted, That the Commission of Enquiry shall have the same powers and authority as are conferred upon the Commission of Enquiry by the Act of the 23rd March 1884, and shall be authorized to employ such clerical and other persons as may be necessary for the proper discharge of their duties, and to pay to such persons such salaries and wages as may be deemed proper by the Commission of Enquiry.
