AN ACT REQUIRING ASSESSORS TO NOTIFY APPLICANTS FOR ABATEMENTS OF UNFAVORABLE ACTION BY CERTIFIED MAIL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 59 of the General Laws is hereby amended by strik-
2 ing out section 63, as most recently amended by chapter 79
3 of the acts of 1943, and inserting in place thereof the following
4 section: —

5 *Section 63.* Assessors shall make a decision on all applica-
6 tions for abatements and shall, within ten days after such de-
7 cision, give written notice thereof to the applicant, and in the
8 case of a refusal of said abatement, such notice shall be sent
9 by certified mail. Said notice shall state that appeal from such
10 decision may be taken as provided in sections sixty-four to
11 sixty-five B, inclusive.
