AN ACT TO PROVIDE UNLIMITED TENURE FOR JAMES V. KING, INCUMBENT OF THE OFFICE OF TOWN ACCOUNTANT OF THE TOWN OF MAYNARD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The tenure of office of James V. King, incum-
2 bent of the office of town accountant of the town of Maynard,
3 shall, upon the effective date of this act, be unlimited, but he
4 may be removed therefrom for cause after hearing in the man-
5 ner provided by section forty-three of chapter thirty-one of the
6 General Laws.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall be submitted for acceptance by
2 said town at its next annual town meeting in the form of the
3 following question which shall be placed on the official ballot
4 to be used for the election of town officers at said meeting:—
5 “Shall an act passed by the General Court in the current year,
6 entitled, ‘An Act to provide unlimited tenure for James V.
7 King, incumbent of the office of town accountant of the town
8 of Maynard’, be accepted?” If a majority of votes in answer
9 to said question is in the affirmative, then this act shall there-
10 upon take full effect, but not otherwise.
