By Mr. Harmon of Boston, petition of Samuel Harmon for repealing the law providing for pre-primary conventions of political parties and reviving and continuing in force certain other laws. Election Laws.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-One.

AN ACT REPEALING THE LAW PROVIDING FOR PRE-PRIMARY CONVENTIONS OF POLITICAL PARTIES, AND REVIVING AND CONTINUING IN FORCE CERTAIN OTHER LAWS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. All provisions of sections fifty-four, fifty-four C,
2 fifty-four D of chapter fifty-three of the General Laws, as most
3 recently amended by chapter two hundred and thirty of the
4 acts of nineteen hundred and fifty-eight, providing for state
5 conventions of political parties for the endorsement for nomina-
6 tion of candidates for offices to be filled by all the voters of the
7 Commonwealth, and all other laws relative to such conventions,
8 are hereby repealed. All provisions of law which have been
9 stricken or amended by said sections fifty-four, fifty-four C,
10 fifty-four D of chapter fifty-three of the General Laws, as most
11 recently amended by chapter two hundred and thirty of the acts
12 of nineteen hundred and fifty-eight, or by any other law relative
13 to such conventions are hereby revived as they existed immedi-
14 ately prior to such striking or amendment, subject, however, to
15 all subsequent amendments not relating to such conventions, all
16 of which subsequent amendments are hereby continued in force.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
