AN ACT RELATIVE TO COMPULSORY AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE RATES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 3 rate for all automobiles registered in the commonwealth of
- 4 Massachusetts, and to establish in connection therewith a
- 5 system of merits and demerits, to provide lower compulsory
- 6 insurance rates for accident-free parties and to provide higher
- 7 compulsory insurance rates for persons responsible for auto-
- 8 mobile accidents.
