AN ACT AMENDING THE STATE LABOR RELATIONS LAW EXTENDING THE WORD "EMPLOYER" TO INCLUDE POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 2 of chapter 150A of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out subsection 2 and inserting in place
3 thereof the following paragraph:—

4 (2) The term, "employer", includes any person acting in the
5 interest of an employer, directly or indirectly, and shall include
6 the departments and divisions of the commonwealth and its
7 political subdivisions, but not any labor organization (other than
8 when acting as an employer) or anyone acting in the capacity of
9 officer or agent of such labor organization.

The Commission of Organization
