## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-One.

AN ACT REQUIRING THE METROPOLITAN TRANSIT AUTHORITY TO  
INSTALL WHITE LINES AT THE EDGE OF PITS IN SUBWAY AND RAPID  
TRANSIT STATIONS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General  
Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The Metropolitan Transit Authority is hereby  
2 authorized and directed to install white lines at least six inches  
3 in width and twenty-four inches from the edge of pits in subway  
4 and rapid transit stations.

1 SECTION 2. Whoever wilfully crosses over such white lines,  
2 unless and until a train is at a full stop within the station, shall  
3 upon conviction thereof forfeit not less than five nor more than  
4 twenty dollars.
