## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-One.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF MALDEN TO CONVEY CERTAIN PARK LAND UNDER SUCH TERMS AND CONDITIONS AS MAY BE DETERMINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The city of Malden may convey a certain parcel  
2 of land in said city which was acquired for park purposes. Said  
3 parcel of land is bounded and described as follows:—

4 LOT 1.

5 A parcel of land belonging, now or late, to the city of Malden,  
6 bounded and described as follows:— Easterly by lands, now  
7 or late, of Allan J. and Grace J. MacDonald and city of Malden,  
8 forty-eight and  $\frac{43}{100}$  (48.43) feet; southeasterly by land, now  
9 or late, of city of Malden, one hundred eighteen and  $\frac{15}{100}$   
10 (118.15) feet; southerly by land, now or late, of city of Malden,  
11 twenty and  $\frac{79}{100}$  (20.79) feet; westerly by lands, now or late,  
12 of Albert and Josephine Giangregorio, Robert A. and Shirley  
13 Jean and E. Foster Queen, one hundred twenty-eight and  
14  $\frac{98}{100}$  (128.98) feet; westerly by land, now or late, of E. Foster  
15 Queen, twenty-six and  $\frac{51}{100}$  (26.51) feet; northerly by land,  
16 now or late, of Charles Margeston, eighty-one and  $\frac{88}{100}$  (81.88)  
17 feet; containing eight thousand eight hundred fifty (8,850)  
18 square feet. This description is intended to conform to a plan  
19 entitled "Plan of Land in Malden, Mass., Scale 40 ft. to an

20 Inch. June 20, 1959. George E. Hayes, Civil Engineer, 101  
21 Altamont Ave., Melrose, Mass."

1 SECTION 2. Said parcel may be sold under such terms and  
2 conditions as may be determined by the mayor and city council  
3 of said city.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take full effect upon its acceptance  
2 by vote of the city council of said city, subject to the provisions  
3 of its charter, but not otherwise.
