AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE FEE CHARGED NON-PROFIT VETERANS' ORGANIZATIONS IN THE CITY OF WORCESTER FOR LICENSES TO SELL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, any
2 non-profit veterans' organization in the city of Worcester shall
3 be charged only one half the usual license fee for the sale of al-
4 coholic beverages if such organization is not subsidized by said
5 city for rental purposes.
