**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-One.

AN ACT EXTENDING THE METROPOLITAN PARKS DISTRICT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 33 of chapter 92 of the General Laws, as  
2 appearing in the Tercentenary Edition, is hereby amended by  
3 striking out the first sentence and inserting in place thereof  
4 the following sentence:— The commission may acquire, main-  
5 tain and make available to the inhabitants of Arlington, Avon,  
6 Bedford, Belmont, Billerica, Boston, Braintree, Brookline,  
7 Burlington, Cambridge, Canton, Chelsea, Cohasset, Concord,  
8 Danvers, Dedham, Dover, Everett, Hingham, Holbrook, Hull,  
9 Lexington, Lincoln, Lynn, Lynnfield, Malden, Marblehead,  
10 Medfield, Medford, Melrose, Middleton, Milton, Nahant,  
11 Natick, Needham, Newton, North Reading, Norwood, Peabody,  
12 Quincy, Randolph, Reading, Revere, Salem, Saugus, Sharon,  
13 Somerville, Stoneham, Stoughton, Swampscott, Wakefield,  
14 Walpole, Waltham, Watertown, Wayland, Wellesley, Weston,  
15 Westwood, Weymouth, Wilmington, Winchester, Winthrop and  
16 Woburn, which shall constitute the metropolitan parks district,  
17 open spaces for exercise and recreation, in this chapter called  
18 reservations; and, for the purpose set forth in this section, the  
19 jurisdiction and powers of the commission shall extend to, and  
20 be exercised in, said district.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on January first, nine-  
2 teen hundred and sixty-two.
