AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY REMOVAL OF OLD AGE ASSISTANCE REAL ESTATE LIENS FOR THE PURPOSE OF PERMITTING REPAIRS AND REQUIRING AN ACCOUNTING OF ASSISTANCE GIVEN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The second paragraph of section 4 of chapter 118A of the
2 General Laws, as most recently amended by chapter 304 of the
3 acts of 1957, is hereby further amended by adding at the end
4 thereof the following three sentences: —

5 A lien taken under this section may be temporarily lifted by
6 the town in order to permit a recipient to finance necessary re-
7 pairs to the real estate. Said lien shall be immediately rein-
8 stated, however, after such arrangements have been made. The
9 town shall annually, upon the written request of a recipient
10 upon whose property a lien has been taken, render a written
11 statement of the amount of money owed under said lien.
