AN ACT PROVIDING FOR A PARTIAL REIMBURSEMENT TO CITIES AND TOWNS OF THE COST OF ADMINISTERING OLD AGE ASSISTANCE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The first sentence of section 8 of chapter 118A of the General  
2 Laws, as appearing in section 8 of chapter 729 of the acts of  
3 1941, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "common-  
4 wealth", in line 5, the words: — and shall further be so reim-  
5 bursed for one half of the expenses of administering this chapter.
