## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

### AN ACT INCREASING THE SALARY OF THE CLERK OF THE SECOND DISTRICT COURT OF BARNSTABLE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Paragraph (1) of section 79 of chapter 218 of the  
2 General Laws, as amended by section 1 of chapter 609 of the  
3 acts of 1959, is hereby further amended by striking out the line  
4 reading "second district court of Barnstable" under the caption  
5 Class I.

1 SECTION 2. Paragraph (1) of section 79 of said chapter 218  
2 is hereby further amended by inserting after the line reading  
3 "The first district court of Barnstable", under the caption  
4 Class III, the following line:—second district court of  
5 Barnstable.
