AN ACT CHANGING THE JOB GROUP OF MEMBERS OF THE UNIFORMED BRANCH OF THE STATE POLICE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law
2 to the contrary, the following personnel of the uniformed branch
3 of the department of public safety shall be classified in the
4 following job groups, under the General Salary Schedule of
5 section forty-six of chapter thirty of the General Laws:—

Lieutenant	Grade 19

Staff Captain	Grade 21
Major and Adjutant	Grade 22
Lieutenant Colonel and Executive Officer	Grade 23
