AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WELFARE TO ESTABLISH RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE RETROACTIVE EFFECT OF APPLICATIONS FOR DISABILITY ASSISTANCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:
