AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ELIGIBILITY FOR PAROLE OF CERTAIN PRISONERS SERVING LIFE SENTENCES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The first sentence of section 133A of chapter 127 of the General
2 Laws, as amended by section 9 of chapter 731 of the acts of 1956,
3 is hereby further amended by striking out, in line 7, the word
4 "twenty" and inserting in place thereof the word: — fifteen.
