AN ACT REQUIRING ASSESSORS OF CITIES AND TOWNS TO NOTIFY OWNERS OF REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY OF ANY INCREASE IN THE FAIR CASH VALUATION THEREOF.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 38 of chapter 59 of the General Laws, as appearing in
2 the Tercentenary Edition, is hereby amended by adding at the
3 end thereof the following sentence:— The assessors of a city or
4 town shall forthwith notify the owner of real or personal prop-
5 erty of any increase made in the fair cash valuation of such
6 property and the reason for such increase.
