AN ACT EXEMPTING CITIES AND TOWNS FROM PAYMENT OF GASOLINE EXCISE TAX FOR MUNICIPALLY OWNED VEHICLES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 8A of chapter 64A of the General Laws, as most re-
2 cently amended by section 1 of chapter 540 of the acts of 1959,
3 is hereby further amended by striking out the first sentence
4 and inserting in place thereof the following sentence:— A dis-
5 tributor duly licensed in this commonwealth may sell fuel tax-
6 free to another person who is licensed as a distributor in this
7 commonwealth, and to any city or town in the commonwealth
8 for the use of municipally owned vehicles.
