The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-One.

AN ACT PROVIDING LIFE TENURE FOR THE OFFICE OF CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF ASSESSORS IN THE CITY OF REVERE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The office of chairman of the board of assessors
2 in the city of Revere shall, upon the effective date of this act,
3 become subject to the civil service laws and rules, and the tenure
4 of office of any incumbent thereof shall be unlimited, subject,
5 however, to said laws.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall be submitted to the voters of said
2 city at the regular election in the form of the following question,
3 which shall be placed on the official ballot to be used at said
4 election:— “Shall an act passed by the general court in the
5 year nineteen hundred and sixty-one, entitled, ‘An Act providing
6 life tenure for the office of chairman of the board of assessors in
7 the city of Revere’ be accepted?” If a majority of the votes in
8 answer to said question is in the affirmative, this act shall take
9 effect, but not otherwise.
