By Mr. Nazzaro of Boston, petition of Gabriel Francis Piemonte prohibiting increases in rates for motor vehicle insurance policies for applicants under twenty-five years of age. Insurance.

AN ACT TO PREVENT AN INCREASE IN CERTAIN MOTOR VEHICLE INSURANCE POLICIES FOR THE CLASSIFICATION OF APPLICANTS UNDER TWENTY-FIVE YEARS OF AGE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 In determining the classifications and premium charges to be
2 used and charged by insurance companies under the provisions
3 of section one hundred and thirteen B of chapter one hundred
4 and seventy-five of the General Laws in connection with the
5 issue or execution of motor vehicle bonds or policies, the com-
6 missioner of insurance shall not fix the premium charges for
7 applicants under twenty-five years of age at a rate higher than
8 that fixed for the calendar year nineteen hundred and sixty
9 for such applicants.
