AN ACT ESTABLISHING A MINIMUM MONTHLY AMOUNT OF SUPER-ANNUATION RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE TO BE PAID TO CERTAIN EMPLOYEES UNDER THE CONTRIBUTORY RETIREMENT LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Subdivision (2) of section 57 of chapter 32 of the General
2 Laws is hereby amended by inserting after paragraph (e), as
3 appearing in section 1 of chapter 661 of the acts of 1957, the
4 following paragraph: —

5 Any member in service or any member inactive on authorized
6 leave of absence classified in Group A, who has been in service
7 for fourteen or more years and who has retired upon attaining
8 the maximum age for said group, shall, notwithstanding the
9 provisions of paragraph (a) of this section, receive as a super-
10 annuation retirement allowance an amount not less than one
11 hundred dollars per month.
