AN ACT INCREASING THE SALARIES OF THE JUSTICES OF THE SUPERIOR COURT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 212 of the General Laws is hereby amended by strik-
2 ing out section 27, as amended by section 2 of chapter 733 of
3 the acts of 1955, and inserting in place thereof the following
4 section:—

5 *Section 27.* The chief justice shall receive a salary of twenty-
6 four thousand dollars and each associate justice a salary of
7 twenty-three thousand dollars, and the chief justice and each
8 associate justice shall annually receive from the commonwealth,
9 upon the certificate of the chief justice, the amount of the ex-
10 pense incurred by them in the discharge of their duties. Such
11 justices shall devote their entire time during ordinary business
12 hours to their respective duties and shall not, directly or indi-
13 rectly, engage in the practice of law.
