**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-One.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO DISCRIMINATION BY THE COMMONWEALTH AND ALL ITS POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS AGAINST EMPLOYEES AND PERSONS SEEKING EMPLOYMENT BETWEEN FORTY-FIVE AND SIXTY-FIVE YEARS OF AGE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 1 of chapter 151B of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by striking out subsection 5, as appearing in chapter  
3 426 of the acts of 1957, and inserting in place thereof the follow-  
4 ing subsection:—

5 5. The term "employer" does not include a club exclusively  
6 social, or a fraternal, charitable, educational or religious associ-  
7 ation or corporation, if such club, association or corporation is  
8 not organized for private profit, nor does it include any employer  
9 with fewer than six persons in his employ, but shall include the  
10 commonwealth and all political subdivisions, boards, depart-  
11 ments and commissions thereof.
