By Mr. Newth of Swampscott, petition of Thomas M. Newth for legislation to increase the salaries of certain clerks of the Superior Court for Essex County. Public Service.

## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-One.

### AN ACT INCREASING THE SALARIES OF CERTAIN CLERKS OF THE SUPERIOR COURT FOR ESSEX COUNTY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 94 of chapter 221 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by striking out the last two paragraphs of said section,  
3 as most recently amended by section 2 of chapter 774 of the  
4 acts of 1949, and inserting in place thereof the following three  
5 paragraphs:—

6 In all other counties, the clerks of the courts shall receive a  
7 sum equivalent to the following percentages of the salary of an  
8 associate justice of the superior court.

Middlesex . . . . .	75%	Hampden . . . . .	65%
Essex . . . . .	75%	Bristol . . . . .	65%
Worcester . . . . .	70%	Norfolk . . . . .	60%
Plymouth . . . . .	55%	Franklin . . . . .	40%

9 In all counties other than Suffolk and Essex, the assistant  
10 clerk shall receive a sum equivalent to seventy-five per cent of  
11 the salary of the clerk, the second assistant clerk shall receive a  
12 sum equivalent to sixty per cent of the salary of the clerk, and  
13 all other assistant clerks shall receive a sum equivalent to fifty-  
14 five per cent of the salary of the clerk.

15 In the county of Essex, the assistant clerk shall receive a  
 16 sum equivalent to seventy-five per cent of the salary of the  
 17 clerk, the second assistant clerk shall receive a sum equivalent  
 18 to seventy per cent of the salary of the clerk, the third assistant  
 19 clerk shall receive a sum equivalent to sixty-five per cent of the  
 20 salary of the clerk, and all other assistant clerks shall receive a  
 21 sum equivalent to sixty per cent of the salary of the clerk.
