RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO POLICIES CONCERNING GOVERNMENTAL EXPENDITURES AND FISCAL POLICIES.

1 *Resolved*, That an unpaid special commission, to consist of  
2 two members of the senate to be designated by the president  
3 thereof, three members of the house of representatives to be  
4 designated by the speaker thereof and two persons to be ap-  
5 pointed by the governor, is hereby established for the purpose  
6 of making an investigation and study relative to policies con-  
7 cerning governmental expenditures and fiscal policies, especially  
8 as these pertain to cities, towns, and counties with reference to  
9 urban centers. Said commission shall be provided with quarters  
10 in the state house or elsewhere, may hold hearings, may require  
11 by summons the attendance and testimony of witnesses and the  
12 production of books and papers, may travel within and without  
13 the commonwealth and may expend for legal, clerical and other  
14 expenses, such sums as may be appropriated therefor. Said  
15 commission shall report the results of its investigation and study  
16 and its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legisla-  
17 tion necessary to carry its recommendations into effect, by  
18 filing the same with the clerk of the house of representatives on  
19 or before the fourth Wednesday of January, nineteen hundred  
20 and sixty-two.
