RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION BY THE JUDICIAL COUNCIL RELATIVE TO THE RECORDING OF NOTICES OF BUILDING PERMITS, ZONING VARIANCES OR SPECIAL PERMITS AND CERTAIN RELATED MATTERS.

1 *Resolved*, That the judicial council be requested to investigate
2 the subject matter of current senate document numbered 255,
3 relative to clarifying notices of limited or conditional variances;
4 of current house document numbered 1369, relative to recording
5 notice of building permits, zoning variances or special permits
6 in the city of Boston; and of current house document numbered
7 1370, relative to recording notice of building permits, zoning
8 variances or special permits, and to include its conclusions and
9 its recommendations, if any, in relation thereto, together with
10 drafts of such legislation as may be necessary to give effect to
11 the same, in its annual report for the current year.
