RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY THE RECODIFICATION COUNSEL RELATIVE TO THE ADVISABILITY OF PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION OF CERTAIN LEGISLATION RELATING TO THE CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE OF HIGHWAYS AND TO THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF ALL STATE AGENCIES, BOARDS, COMMISSIONS AND DEPARTMENTS.

1     *Resolved*, That the recodification counsel is hereby authorized  
2 and directed to make an investigation and study of the subject  
3 matter of current house documents numbered 87, relative to  
4 providing for the codification of all previously enacted legisla-  
5 tion pertaining to the construction and maintenance of high-  
6 ways; and 830, relative to providing for the appointment of a  
7 special commission to study and codify all rules and regulations  
8 made by all state agencies, boards, commissions and depart-  
9 ments, and to provide for the publication of said rules and  
10 regulations as an appendix to the General Laws of the common-  
11 wealth. Said counsel shall report to the general court the results  
12 of its investigation and study, together with drafts of legislation  
13 necessary to carry its recommendations, if any, into effect, by  
14 filing the same with the clerk of the senate on or before the  
15 fourth Wednesday of December in the current year.
