AN ACT REQUIRING PROPER VENTILATION IN CERTAIN PLACES OF EMPLOYMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 149 of the General Laws is hereby amended by strik-
2 ing out section 117, as amended by chapter 208 of the acts of
3 1935, and inserting in place thereof the following section:—

4 *Section 117.* Every establishment in which a person or per-
5 sons are employed shall be so ventilated that all gases, vapors,
6 dust, fumes, or any impurity injurious to health, whether gen-
7 erated in the course of the work carried on therein or otherwise,
8 shall, so far as practicable, be rendered harmless.
