AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CONSTRUCTION OF CERTAIN BUILDINGS AT THE ESSEX COUNTY AGRICULTURAL SCHOOL AND THE REMODELING OF AND/OR THE MAKING OF AN ADDITION TO AN EXISTING BUILDING THEREAT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The trustees of the Essex County Agricultural
2 School are hereby authorized to construct a general purpose
3 building, including facilities for physical education instruction,
4 and to remodel and extend or replace present heating plant
5 facilities as may be necessary to provide heat for the increased
6 facilities, for the use of said school.

1 SECTION 2. For the purpose aforesaid, the treasurer of said
2 county, with the approval of the county commissioners, may
3 borrow upon the credit of the county such sums as may be
4 necessary, not exceeding in the aggregate, three hundred and
5 fifty thousand dollars, and may issue bonds or notes of the
6 county thereof. Each authorized issue shall constitute a sepa-
7 rate loan and such loans shall be payable not more than ten
8 years from their dates. The bonds or notes shall be signed by
9 the county treasurer and countersigned by a majority of the
10 county commissioners. The county may sell the said securities
11 at public or private sale, upon such terms and conditions as the
12 county commissioners may deem proper, but not for less than
13 their par value. Indebtedness incurred hereunder shall, except
14 as herein provided, be subject to chapter thirty-five of the Gen-
15 eral Laws.

1 SECTION 3. The county treasurer of said county, with the
2 approval of the county commissioners, may issue temporary
3 notes of the county, payable in not more than one year from
4 their dates, in anticipation of the issue of serial bonds or notes
5 under this act, but the time within which such serial bonds or

6 notes shall become due and payable shall not, by reason of such
7 temporary notes, be extended beyond the time fixed by this act.
8 Any notes issued in anticipation of the serial bonds or notes shall
9 be paid from the proceeds thereof.

1 SECTION 4. This act shall take full effect upon its acceptance,
2 during the current year, by the county commissioners of the
3 county of Essex, but not otherwise.
