3 relative to requiring forty-eight hour notice prior to the hearing
4 of court cases, and to include its conclusions and its recommenda-
5 tions, if any, in relation thereto, together with drafts of such
6 legislation as may be necessary to give effect to the same, in its
7 annual report for the current year.
