In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-One.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE WEST AND SOUTH WATER SUPPLY DISTRICT OF ACTON SHALL NOT USE THE TOWN OF BOXBOROUGH AS A SOURCE OF WATER SUPPLY FOR A PERIOD OF ONE YEAR.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provision of chapter three
2 hundred and twenty-six of the acts of nineteen hundred and
3 twelve to the contrary, the West and South Water Supply Dis-
4 trict of Acton shall not use the town of Boxborough as a source
5 of water supply for a period of one year from the effective date
6 of this act.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
