AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE USE OF MEDICAL DEPOSITIONS AT TRIALS IN THE ABSENCE OF ATTENDING PHYSICIANS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 233 of the General Laws is hereby amended by in-
2 serting after section 25 the following section:—

3 *Section 25A.* A physician who has treated or examined a
4 party to a civil cause or proceeding involving personal injuries
5 may be summoned and compelled to give his deposition at any
6 place within ten miles of his place of residence relative to the
7 history, diagnosis, treatment, prognosis and period of dis-
8 ability of said party and such depositions may be admitted in
9 evidence at the trial of such cause in the absence of such physi-
10 cian.
