## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-One.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE INDEMNIFICATION OF PUBLIC SCHOOL  
TEACHERS FOR CERTAIN EXPENSES OR DAMAGES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 100C of chapter 41 of the General Laws, inserted by  
2 chapter 451 of the acts of 1959, is hereby amended by adding at  
3 the end the following: — or, if such defense or settlement was  
4 not made by such solicitor, counsel or attorney, such city or  
5 town had failed or refused, for a period of sixty days after its  
6 school committee had been notified in writing of the pendency  
7 of such action or claim, to provide for such defense or settlement  
8 on behalf of such teacher by such solicitor, counsel or attorney.
