AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD TO REIMBURSE THE WIDOW OF DANIEL J. LAWLER FOR THE EXPENSES OF HIS FUNERAL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of discharging a moral obliga-
2 tion, the city of Springfield may appropriate and pay to the
3 widow of Daniel J. Lawler, who died June twenty-ninth, nine-
4 teen hundred and fifty-eight, as a result of injuries sustained
5 while in the performance of his duty as a member of the fire
6 department of said city, a sum not exceeding twelve hundred
7 and thirty-seven dollars, in reimbursement of the expenses of
8 his funeral.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take full effect upon its acceptance
2 during the current year by vote of the city council of said city,
3 subject to the provisions of its charter, but not otherwise.
