AN ACT VALIDATING CERTAIN AMENDMENTS TO THE ZONING BY-LAWS OF THE TOWN OF BILLERICA.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The amendments to the zoning by-laws of the
2 town of Billerica adopted during the current year and described
3 in Articles 39, 40, 56 and 88 of the warrant for the annual town
4 meeting held in said town in the current year are hereby con-
5 firmed and made valid notwithstanding the failure to comply
6 with the provisions of law relative to changes in zoning by-laws.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
