By Mr. Foley of Springfield, petition of Bernard J. Pat Foley that the city of Springfield be directed to use certain funds received from the Commonwealth for the development of the Blunt Park area in said city. Municipal Finance.

AN ACT DIRECTING THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD TO USE CERTAIN FUNDS FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF RECREATIONAL FACILITIES IN THE BLUNT PARK AREA IN SAID CITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law
2 to the contrary, the city of Springfield shall use all funds re-
3 ceived by it from the commonwealth as a result of the land tak-
4 ing made in the Blunt park area in said city for the construction
5 of the East-West expressway by the department of public works
6 for the development of recreational facilities and areas in said
7 park area.
